

THINGS TO REMEMBER

This list has been prepared to assist you with the funeral arrangement process. Bring the following items with you at the time you meet with the Funeral Director. If you are unable to locate particular documents or items, that is fine. The Funeral Director may be able to assist you with acquiring information or items that you may not have.

1. VITAL STATISTICS

- Decedent's date and place of birth, social security number, level of education, father's name and mother's maiden name.

2. CEMETERY INFORMATION

- If the decedent or someone in the family owns cemetery plots that you would like to use, bring documentation.

3. CLOTHING

- Women: Outer garments should be full sleeve and have a high neck line. You will also need panty hose or stockings, underwear, a bra, full or half slip. **Please No Sheer Garments.**
- Men: Suit, shirt and tie. If you will not use a suit, that is fine. You will also need a t-shirt, underwear and socks.

4. MILITARY VETERAN'S

- Please bring Honorable Discharge (DD2-14) or documentation verifying military service.

5. INSURANCE

- If you intend to use life insurance to pay for the funeral expenses, please bring either original policy or policy number. **Insurance policy must be effective for at least two years in order to be applied to cover funeral expenses.**

6. PICTURE

- Please bring a recent photo of your loved one.
